B. Experience : - Minimum of five years cost engineering experience including at least three years devoted to petrochemical, refinery, pipeline, or power generation projects. Must be familiar with construction practices, materials, equipment.

- for none engineers, minimum seven (7) years cost engineering experience is required.

Alternate II

A. Education : Certified by Institute of Building, Institute of Quantity Surveying, Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors, HNC, HND.

B. Experience : Eight years cost engineering experience including at least four years concentrated toward heavy industrial capital projects. Must be familiar with construction practices, materials and equipment.

Alternate III

A. Education : Associate Degree or ONC, with City and Guilds

B. Experience : Minimum of ten years cost engineering experience including a minimum of five years concentrated toward heavy industrial- type projects. Must be familiar with construction practices, materials, and equipment.

C. Must have ability to communicate fluently in both spoken and written English.
